## **POLICY STATEMENT**

With respect to the treatment of students and their parents, the Director of Education shall not cause or allow practices or conditions to exist within the organization that are unfair, unsafe, otherwise inconsistent with Catholic values and teachings or disrespectful.

The Director of Education shall not:

- 1. Permit decisions or procedures that does not recognize and respect parents as those with primary responsibility for education and protection of their children.
  - 1.1 Let students OR parents be unacquainted with school-based expectations of student performance and conduct.
  - 1.2 Permit key decisions involving the education of their children be made without parental participation.
  - 1.3 Permit parents to be without clear, timely and responsive communications regarding progress and activity of their children.
- 2. Permit violation of students and parents' legislated rights for privacy and confidentiality.
- 3. Permit students and parents to be without due process in the event of an appeal.
- 4. Permit any school-authorized activities to be inappropriately supervised.

Method: Internal

5. Permit students to be without all reasonable protections against hazards or conditions that might threaten a safe, healthy, respectful and secure learning environment.

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
